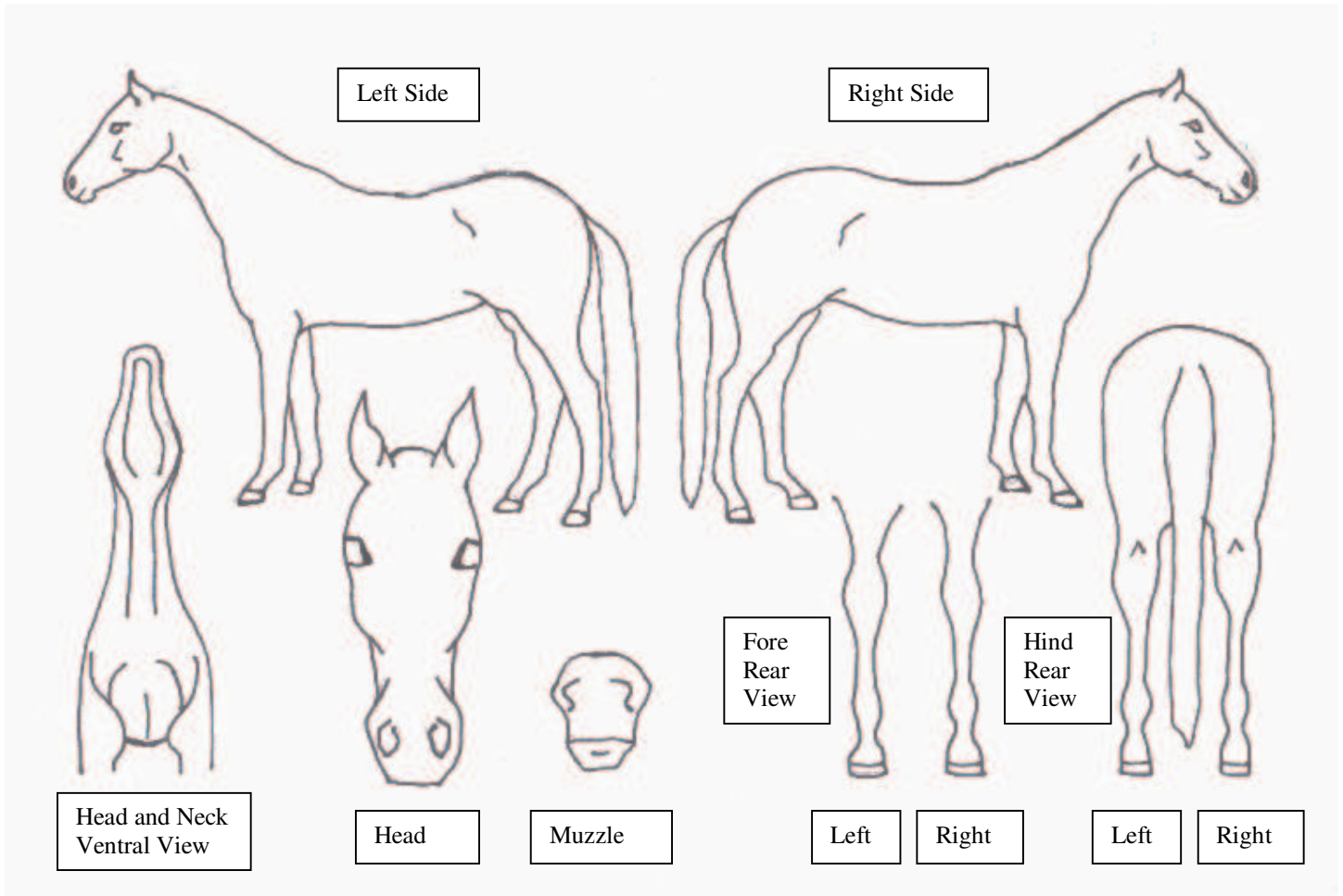


Identification Chart

The diagrams and written descriptions must be of sufficient detail to ensure positive identification of the animal in the future. White markings are to be shown in red. Flesh marks are to be shown in blue. Whorls are to be marked with an "X". Acquired markings are to be marked with an "A" and other distinguishing marks such as a Prophet's Thumb are to be marked with a Δ.
